

Uniform Grant Information September 2024 – Year 6 to 7 Transition Pupils Only

If your child doesn't receive Free School Meals

If you think that your child might be entitled to Free School Meals, but isn't already receiving them, please apply by clicking <u>https://education.hackney.gov.uk/content/apply-free-school-meals</u>

A successful application will entitle your child to Uniform Grant (see below) and will also entitle your child to a Free School Lunch each day at Skinners'. Our caterers, Olive Dining, provide a canteen service of hot and cold food (see our Admissions Information Booklet for more information)

If your child receives Free School Meals and lives in Hackney

- 1. you apply for Uniform Grant (via our Admissions Form), and
- 2. Hackney Council (if your child attends a Hackney primary/your child's primary school (if primary school is not in Hackney) confirms to us that your child is entitled to Free School Meals,

Then you will be given a reduction of £100 from the cost of uniform at Rough Cut Casuals.

If your child receives Free School Meals and lives outside Hackney

You should apply for Uniform Grant to your child's home borough first.

Haringey (£60)- apply here <u>https://myaccount.haringey.gov.uk/service/free_school_meals_and_school_clothing_grant</u>

Islington (£150) – apply here Free school meals and uniform grant | Islington Council

Other boroughs - please check your council's website

If the grant received from the home borough is less than £100, please provide us with evidence of the grant and Skinners' will make a top up grant via a reduction at Rough Cut Casuals (to make the total up to £100).

If your child doesn't receive Free School Meals, but you receive Universal Credit and earn, yearly, a net income of no more than £15,400

Whichever borough your child lives in, you should apply for Uniform Grant (via our Admissions Form) and provide us with

- 1. a copy of a recent official confirmation of Universal Credit for the current tax year and
- 2. a recent monthly pay slip

(Neither should be more than 3 months old),

These should either

- copied and posted to us for the attention of Mrs Howard, or

If your application is successful, you will be given a reduction of £100 from the cost of uniform at Rough Cut Casuals.

If your child doesn't receive Free School Meals, but you receive Working Tax Credit, getting no more than £16,190

Whichever borough your child lives in, you should apply for Uniform Grant (via our Admissions Form) and provide use with

- 1. a copy of a recent official confirmation of Working Tax Credit for the current tax year, and
- 2. a recent monthly pay slip

(Neither should be more than 3 months old)

These should either

- be brought to our reception for copying between 9-4pm during term time (we are closed from 4pm on Friday 26 May, re-opening on Monday 5 June), or
- copied and posted to us for the attention of Mrs Howard, or
- scanned or photographed and emailed to <u>admissions@skinnersacademy.org.uk</u>

If your application is successful, you will be given a reduction of £100 from the cost of uniform at Rough Cut Casuals.

Application deadline

All applications should be made via the relevant section of the admissions form, a link to which is emailed to the parent/carers of successful Year 6 applicants. The closing date for Grant Applications is 31 August 2024, but applications received after 30 June 2024 may not be processed until after the summer holiday, so we recommend that you provide us with all supporting evidence for your application before 30 June 2024.
